Then type any one of these terms

(or any term you choose) in the search box:

**ELIZABETH I QUEEN OF ENGLAND**

**ENGLISH DRAMA ELIZABETHAN**

Limit your results by clicking on choices in the

**NARROW YOUR SEARCH** frame on the left hand side of the screen.

Limit by **LIBRARY, AGE LEVEL, FICTION OR NONFICTION**, etc.
